

Messaging Security Release Notes

Overview

Release 8.1 is a major release that includes a new feature, some enhancements and bug fixes.

New Features

Below is a description of the new feature added to our messaging security solution.

Email Continuity

Email continuity allows a customer to access mail spooled and accrued on either the hosted platform or their MAG appliance when their mail server goes offline via an alternative webmail interface. All mail is spooled until their mail system recovers and then all held mail is delivered. Bcc'd copies of replies, newly composed and sent messages during the time of the outage are delivered as well and can be filtered to be placed in the users' sent mail folder. A verifier is available that syncs user-level login credentials for use when the mail server and/or directory is offline. Customers can begin archiving their valid messages for up to 35 days. These messages are viewable and available when Email Continuity is enabled.

This feature requires an additional license and it's configurable through your current Admin Dashboard as well as the product's API. These feature can be enabled for both hosted and appliance customers.

Feature Enhancements

Below is a list of feature enhancements that have been added to our messaging security solution.

- a. Appliance administrators can now disable a protocol check for mal-formed MIME message headers. This control is available as a syntax option in the MAG dashboard under the Settings section and the SMTP TAB in the Greylisting section.
- b. Sorting by report column is now available for the following reports: Advanced, Recent Activity, Outbound Quarantine and Outbound Activity reports.
- c. Added DNS validation checks so internal LAN addresses cannot be entered for DNS publishing for MX and URL records via the MAG dashboard
- d. Added auto-adjusting for MAX Message Size based on MAG appliance type to avoid "out of memory" conditions. MAG units 1500, 2000 and 2500 will have the default MAX Message Size set to 50 MBs to improve performance.

Fixed Bugs

- 8856** There was an issue for email addresses entered that contained quotes which was resolved.
- 8490** When deleting the last subscribed Global Report it directed to HTTP error 404
- 8694** Fixed an issue with the Quick Release feature for quarantined messages that directed to HTTP 500 error page
- 8700** Fixed an issue with negative values being presented on Outbound Message Category Summary report
- 8757** Fixed an issue where senders on blacklist were triggering the outbound rate limit for users
- 8718** Corrected an internal configuration error that allowed MAX Message Size entered as 100 MB to equate to "zero" and in effect unlimited that generated some "out of memory" conditions

- 8710** Corrected an issue where you couldn't add a 2nd IP to the MAG dashboard Sender Allow List
- 8745** Corrected an issue where "Account requires attention" notice and URL link would direct to an empty page
- 8779** Corrected an issue where sending a test message would corrupt the page displayed
- 8859** Corrected an issue where even after not including a filter Action "Accept" or "Markup" it would continue to not filter out those messages
